APPLICATION FOR CONSIDERATION

PURPOSE

This fund was established to provide partial scholarships to members of Workers United Ontario Council, their children and grandchildren. This is to encourage members' families, as representatives of the diverse cultural communities which make up the Workers United Ontario Council, in accessing high quality post-secondary education.

ELIGIBILITY

Any student who has graduated or who will be graduating, from an Ontario High School or an equivalent program and will be attending a recognized post-secondary institution such as a college or university, and is a member, or the child or grandchild of a Workers United Ontario Council member in good standing, is eligible to apply for consideration. A Workers United member shall be limited to one scholarship.

AWARD

Two scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis to the successful applicant as chosen by the Fund's Academic Committee. The scholarship will be \$1,500.

CRITERIA

The Fund's Academic Committee will review all Applications for consideration received. Scholarships will be awarded at the discretion of the Fund's Academic committee which will consider the following criteria:

- Essay submission;
- Involvement in community activities including; multi-cultural, religious, athletic and any other organizations;
- Paid or volunteer work experience;
- Secondary School marks and academic achievement;
- Life Experience;
- Equity considerations.

3. Please attach a certified academic transcript from your Secondary School and any other relevant documentation.
